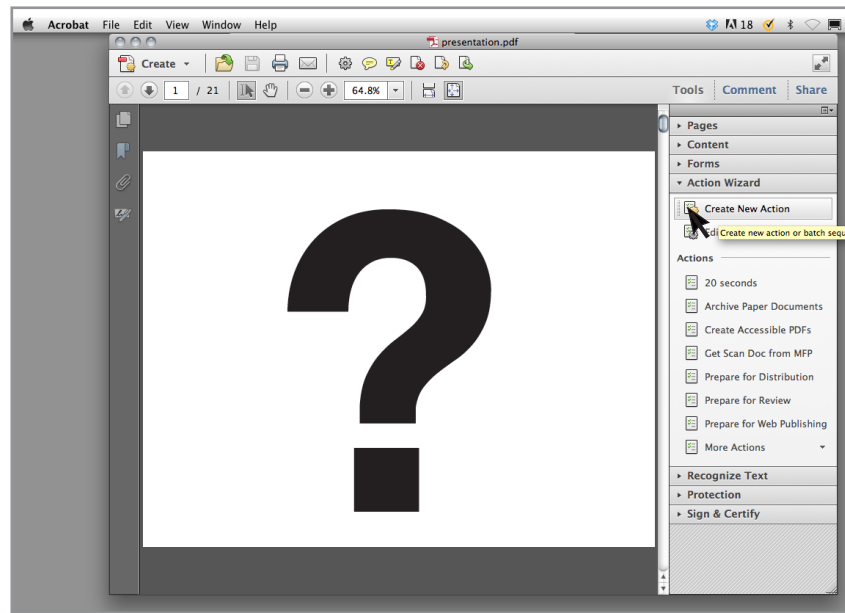
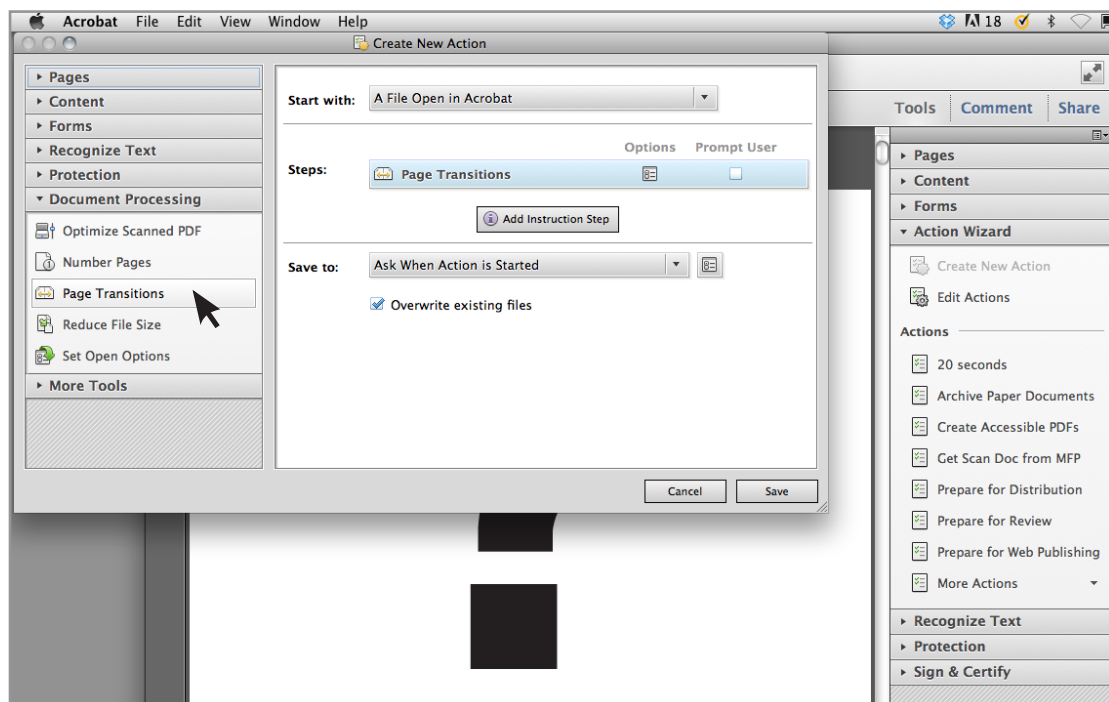


How to set Auto-Timer in Acrobat Pro

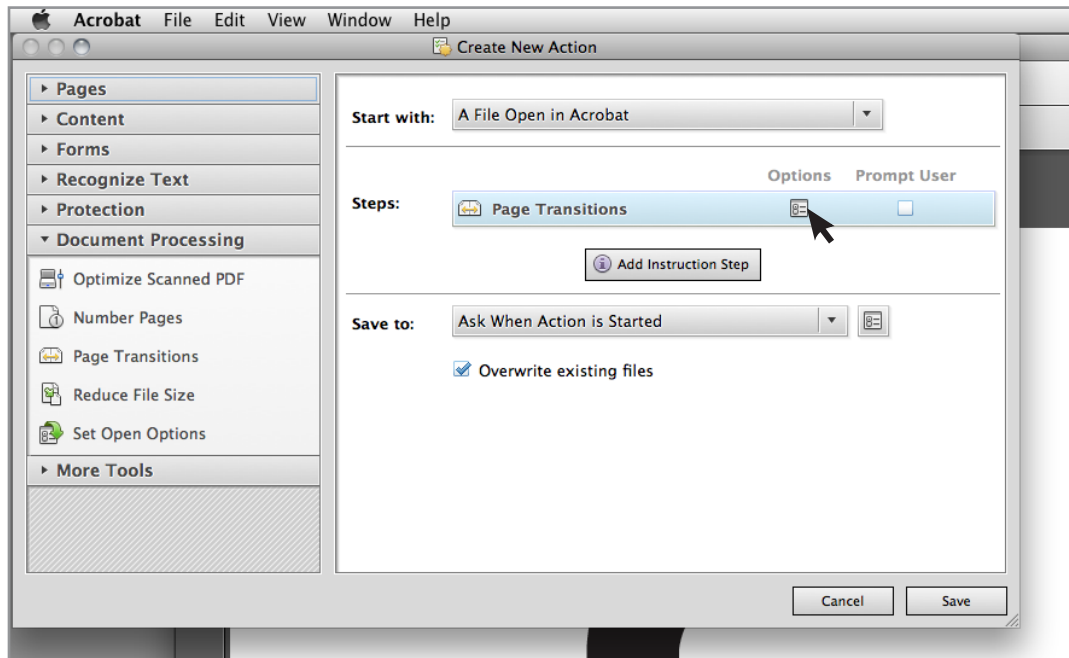
Create your document, export it to PDF, and open the document in Acrobat Pro. On the right-hand menu, click "Tools". Then, click "Action Wizard". Then, click the top button from the drop-down menu, "Create New Action".



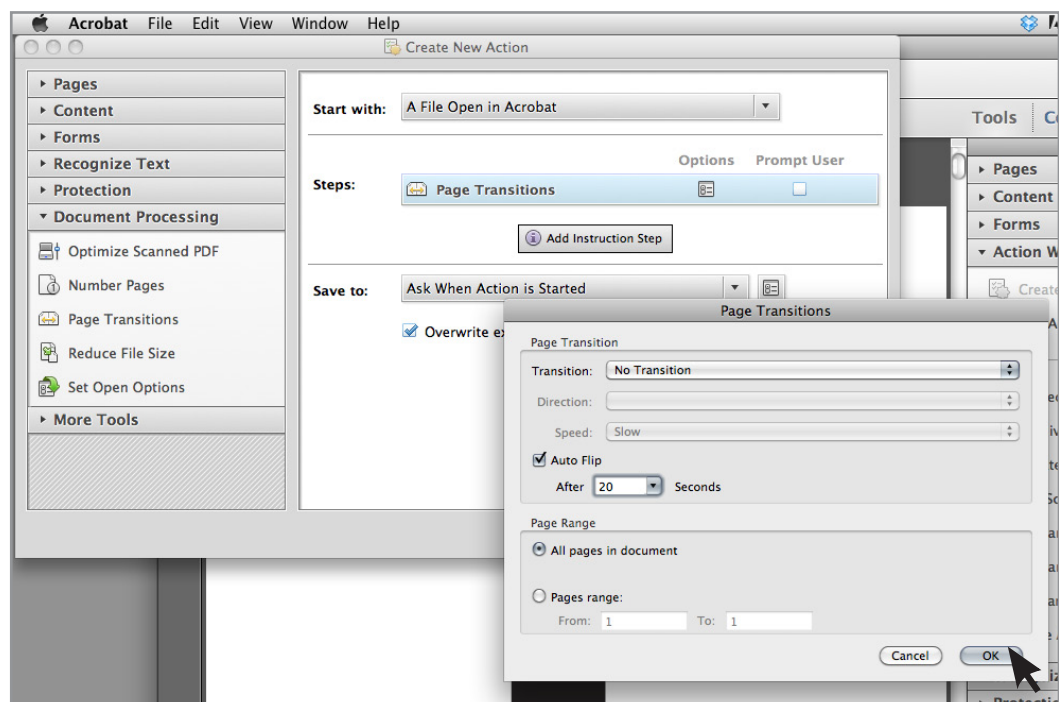
In the "Create New Action" window, click on "Document Processing" in the drop-down menu. Then, click on "Page Transitions" in the sub-menu.



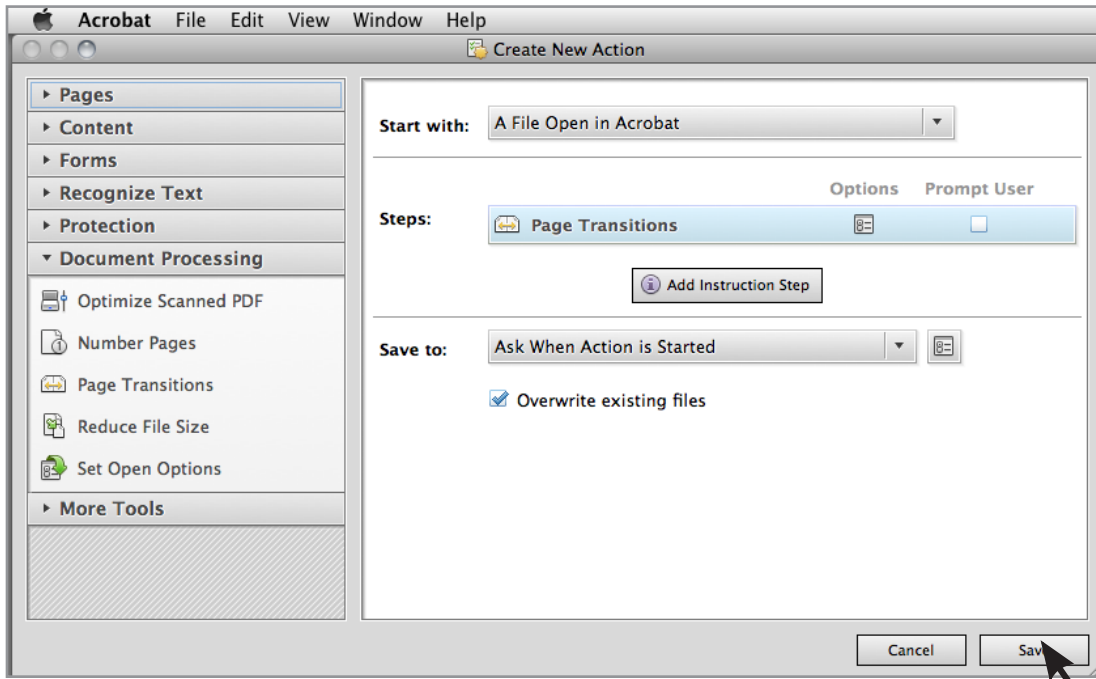
Under "Steps", click on the icon underneath "Options"



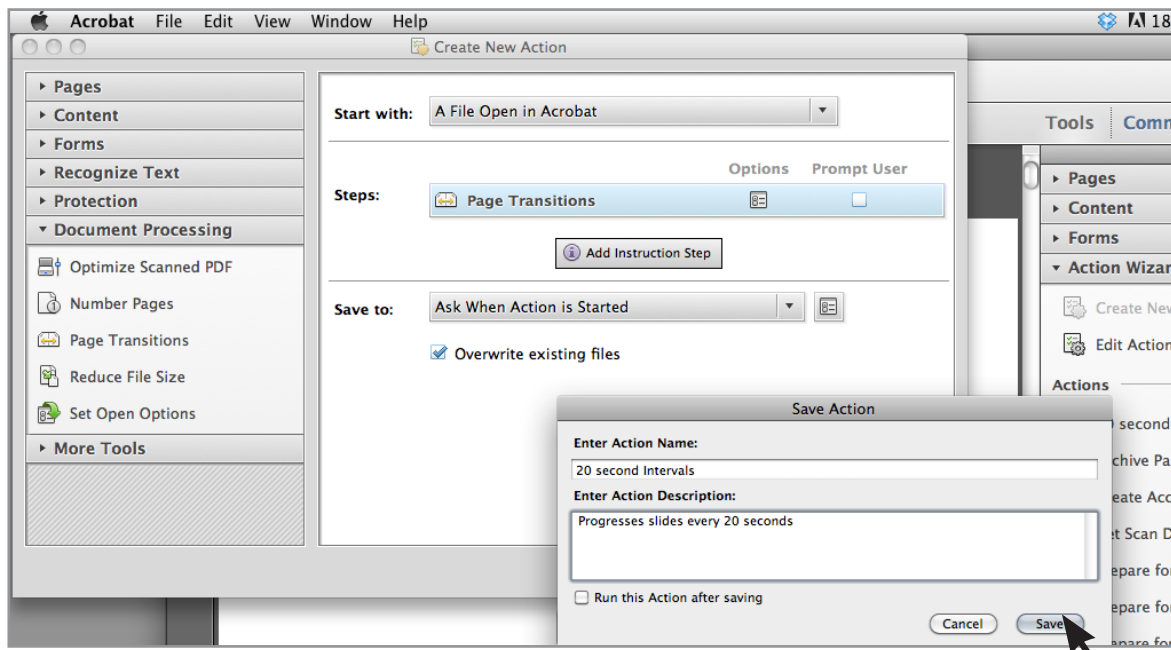
The "Page Transitions" window will open. Click the Auto-Flip box, and type in the number of seconds you want each page to be on screen (for Pecha Kucha, type in 20). Click "OK".



The Transitions window will close, click “Save” in the “Create New Action” window.



The “Save Action” window will open. Give your action a name and description, click “Save” and Voila! You have a new action. This action is now attached to your document. You will need to save the document to keep the action live. Note: Page Transitions are only viewable in Full Screen Mode (Command-L or Control-L)



Your action is now saved on your computer. When you want to attach this action to another document, click on Tools > Action Wizard > Next. Then save your document and the action will be attached to it.
